FOSTER CARE - (PARENT) AGREEMENT

This agreement entered into between Save a Kitty Feral Cat Program, Inc. (a non-profit animal welfare organization) in Parkersburg, WV and the undersigned (foster parent, caretaker, etc.), in consideration of the mutual promises contained in this Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, the organization and the foster parent agree to the following terms and conditions, intending to be legally bound:

Cats/Kittens

We are delivering the following described cats/kittens to you for temporary boarding and foster care for a reasonable time period, in order to prepare them for permanent adoption.

Foster Care

You (the foster parent) will provide the foster care in your home at the address indicated in this agreement, in an area segregated from your own cats and from any other cats you are fostering, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Your foster care for the cats will be comprised of the following:

- Providing wholesome cat food, water and clean litter pans daily;
- Bottle feeding for kittens, if necessary;
- Providing a warm, safe place inside your home;
- Administering medicines, if needed;
- Transporting to the veterinarian, if necessary
- Socializing and playing (unless the cat is feral and can not be tamed); and

Veterinary Care

When veterinary care is needed, you will use the usual veterinarian for the cats/kittens:

You will telephone the Foster Coordinator of this organization at the telephone number given to advise her/him of any emergencies involving the cats/kittens, for pre-approval of non-emergency veterinary care and also on a regular weekly basis to advise the Foster Coordinator of the animals progress.

No Liability

You are not liable to us for any injuries to, illness or disappearance of the cats/kittens arising out of the foster care, except if such injuries, illness or disappearance are caused by or arise out of your gross negligence or intentional misconduct. We are not liable for any bodily injury or property damage, losses or injuries whatsoever to you or other persons, or to your or another persons pets, caused by the actions, behavior or health of the cats/kittens, or arising out of the foster care, except if such damage, losses or injuries are caused by our gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

Termination of Services

You agree to contact us immediately by telephone in the event that you are no longer able or willing to provide foster care to any or all of the cats/kittens. You will continue to care for the cats/kittens for a reasonable period until we are able to come to your home to retrieve any cats/kittens being returned, or until we can accept the return of the cats/kittens from you to place with another foster parent. We will notify you by telephone whenever we wish to retrieve any or all of the cats/kittens whether for adoption into a permanent home or any other reason. You will cooperate with us by promptly arranging a mutually satisfactory time for us to pick up any cats/kittens being returned. You may not entrust the care of the cats/kittens to any other person or relocate them.

Adoption by Caretaker

In the event that a foster parent wishes to adopt any or all of the cats/kittens as a household pet(s), you must first enter in to our Care Contract and if the cat/kitten is not yet sterilized, also enter into our Sterilization Agreement.

Loaned Equipment and Supplies

We are temporarily providing you with the following equipment and supplies for use in providing the foster care: _____

 You will return these items to us in good, clean condition (subject to normal wear and tear) at the end of the Foster Care period, or whenever we request them. If the foregoing items are lost, stolen, or damaged beyond normal wear and tear as a result of your negligence or misconduct, you will promptly pay us the replacement price to purchase new items.

Entire Agreement; Modifications; Binding Effect

This agreement is the entire agreement between you and us. Any modification to the agreement must be in writing, signed by both you and us. This agreement binds your and our respective heirs, executors, personal representatives, successors and assigns.
