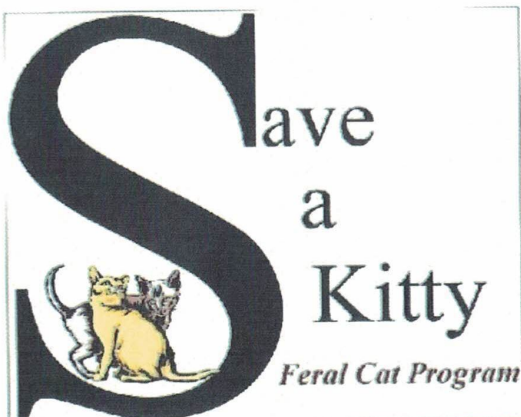


**Save a Kitty FCP volunteers' assist with TNR education for the community. TNR is Trap, Neuter, Return**

- **We** train residents on how to humanely trap all the cats in the colony that they are feeding for spay/neuter surgeries, ear-tipping for identification, vaccinations and other Veterinarian services needed for the cats.
- **We** raise funds and make appointments with our Veterinarians to perform the surgeries and then return the cats to their established outdoor area after a recuperation period.
- **We** ask residents to continue feeding, watering and sheltering the cats for the remainder of their lives while monitoring the cats for health issues.

Millions of feral and free-roaming cats and kittens routinely die in shelters because they are "un-adoptable". The fact is, they have a home. It's outdoors. Save a Kitty FCP advocates for the humane method of TNR.

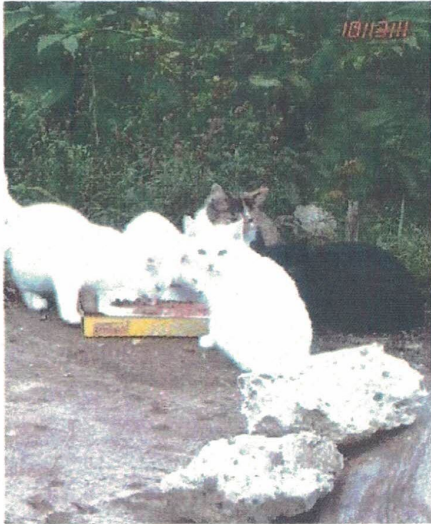
